Objectives

The Master's degree in Languages and International Management offers international students the opportunity to acquire fundamental knowledge in subjects such as International Management, Financial Management, European Law and European Business law. Students also follow an intensive French language programme.

Students eligible for master 1 in LAME:

Proficiency in English (C1), Upper intermediate level (B2) in French and BA level in fundamental subjects including Economics, Management and Business.

Semester 4

> Options: Economic Intelligence, International Trade (Payment Techniques), European Project Funding

> Internship (4 to 6 months), Apprenticeship, Dissertation
